Bishop Felipe Lozada-Montañez

The Rev. Felipe Lozada-Montañez was elected Bishop of the ELCA Caribbean synod in 2007. When elected, he was serving as pastor of San Juan Lutheran Church, Dorado, Puerto Rico, and mission director for the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America.

Born in Toa Baja, Puerto Rico, Lozada-Montañez received his bachelor's degree in math and physics and a master of education degree in administration and supervision, both from Puerto Rico University, Rio Piedras. Lozada-Montañez received a master of divinity degree from Puerto Rico Evangelical Seminary, San Juan, in 1997. He has served as mission developer and pastor of San Juan Lutheran Church since his ordination in 1997. In 1999, Lozada-Montañez became a member of the Caribbean Synod Council.

Lozada-Montañez resides with his wife, Ana, in Dorado. He is the parent of three adult sons.

The ELCA Caribbean Synod has approximately 4,000 baptized members in 33 congregations. The synod office is in Dorado.
