Constitutional Amendment – Proposed by Synod Council

The Synod Council has approved the following Constitutional amendment change for Chapter 7 – Synod Assembly. It was presented at the 2017 Synod Assembly and will be brought before the 2018 Synod Assembly for adoption. According to Chapter 18. Amendments, Bylaws, and Continuing Resolutions:

†S18.13 (b) The Synod Council may propose an amendment, with notice to be sent to the congregations of the synod at least six months prior to the next regular meeting of the Synod Assembly. Such an amendment shall require for adoption a two-thirds vote of the voting members present and voting at such a regular meeting of the Synod Assembly.

S7.14. One half of the number of members of the Synod Assembly registered at a regular meeting of the Synod Assembly shall constitute a quorum for that meeting and any special meeting of the Synod Assembly meeting thereafter until the next regular meeting.
