#### **Confession and Forgiveness**

L: Siblings in faith, God is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love. Trusting in this grace and mercy, let us confess our sins before God and one another.

#### Silence for reflection

#### L: Loving God,

C: we confess that we have not always lived up to your claim upon our lives. We fail to see your image in the faces of our neighbors and in ourselves. We turn away from your call to care for the vulnerable people in our community and in our world. We hide away from you and forget that you love us wholeheartedly, no matter what. Forgive us, God. Open our eyes to the love you have for us and those we meet. Inspire us to share that love with others. Remind us that we can never stray so far that you won't call us back. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen

L: Beloved in Christ, hear the good news. God loves you more than you will ever know. In the name of Christ, your sins are forgiven. Rejoice, take heart, and move forward in faith, trusting that God in Christ Jesus is with you always.

C: Thanks be to God! Amen
